 - 1 Woodlands Road demolition appeal – pending.

The next 'Local Community Meeting – This is not a Police Meeting' will be on the 14 March 2016 and as this is not a police meeting Alan James will not be attending.

9. We may need to prepare a leaflet in April for the May elections – we looked at the last leaflet we used.
10. Canewdon are working on a Neighbourhood Plan and Hullbridge are considering one. Ralph Chapman suggested we should produce a new plan for Hockley as the current Parish Plan is nearly 10 years old. We decide that as the current plan has been ignored, a new plan is not necessary.
