Minutes of Hockley Residents Association Meeting held on Tuesday the 8 August 2017 at 7.30 pm in Greensward Academy chaired by Chair Alan James. The residents' meeting was attended by 7 members / visitors and the following topics were discussed:

1. Alan James's Hockley shops report.
2. Alan James's Hockley local publication and website report. We discussed recycling and litter picking.
3. Brian O'Shea's Coach Trip report.
4. Brian O'Shea's Day Centre report.
5. Brian O'Shea's Planning report. AJ will chase up the traffic count. AJ has checked for new planning proposals for Hockley Primary School, Hockley Community Centre and Folly Chase area. The only plan he has found is an approved plan for a single story modular class room building at the school.
6. David Claydon Flood Forum report – ongoing.
7. John Worden is working on the audit. AJ is hoping the audit will be complete for the AGM in October.
8. Rubbish on Bullwood Hall footpath. David Claydon will check if complete – ongoing.
9. Possible closure of Hockley Toilets. RDC decision still deferred – ongoing.
10. RDC councillors' group have set up pollution monitoring in Hockley – ongoing.
11. Folly Lane new homes and allotments – ongoing.
12. Church Road traffic – ongoing.
13. Westerings School doubling in size – congestion, parking and speeding issues. Our meeting voted unanimously to reimburse AJ for the £52 printing cost of the 500 leaflets he personally distributed to the whole of the Westerings estate.
14. Proposed development at Bullwood Hall. A new developer, Sanctuary Group, has taken over and proposes a 20 home increase.
15. Malcolm Sewell gave us an update on the Massive Project and the danger that it could close due to the loss of funds from Hockley Parish Council. Our meeting voted unanimously to support them with further a £500 donation.
