14. Proposed development at Bullwood Hall – ongoing.
15. Massive Project £500 donation will be handed over when once we have been informed that the appeal has been fully subscribed – ongoing.
16. AJ has been assured by Shaun Scrutton that the milestone in Hall Lane will soon be reinstated. AJ will chase this up again. AJ has also had unconfirmed reports of a milestone laying down on the corner of Wood Avenue and Plumberow Avenue.
17. AJ informed the meeting that we may lose the use of Greensward Academy venue. Adrian Eves will write to try to get this facility continued – ongoing.
